**8th Grade - 8:30am – 9:15am - Go directly to the Library to make donations, purchase your yearbook, planner and PE clothes.
8th grade students will not be allowed on campus after 9:15am.**

*****DON'T FORGET*****

Free Mile Pass to all 8th Graders who return a completed Donation Receipt Form and hand it in at Orientation between 8:30am – 9:15am.

7th Grade – 8:30 am - Drop your students in large gym and proceed to the small gym for a presentation by our principal, Jennifer Platt. You will be able to purchase your items after the presentation.

- 1. Complete the attached Donation Receipt Form and come to Orientation. We now accept credit cards (no minimum donation required) as well as checks (payable to “Cavitt PTC”) and cash. Forms will be available both in the office prior to Orientation and the day of Orientation.**
 - PTC Donation (tax deductible): Invest in your child's education. Every dollar donated stays at Cavitt. Your money goes to important programs like school assemblies, elective/enrichment classes, technology equipment, the Art Docent Program, the Academic Achievement Luncheon, Graduation, Staff Appreciation and more. This is PTC's one pledge drive for the year! In the wake of devastating budget cuts, ensure that your PTC can step up when asked to fill the gaps. The suggested voluntary donation per student is \$125, but any amount is appreciated.**
 - Classroom Donation (tax deductible): This goes towards classroom supplies not otherwise covered by the PTC or EUSD, such as white boards and markers for math instruction, folders for new math curriculum, new novels for use in 7th and 8th grade,**

U.S. Constitution pocket guides, etc. The suggested voluntary donation per student is \$50, but any amount is appreciated.

- **School Technology Donation (tax deductible):** Our current funding makes it difficult to keep our student computer labs stocked with technology supplies. These funds will be used only for technology supplies such as paper, equipment, CD's, etc. The suggested voluntary donation per student is \$30, but any amount is appreciated.
 - **Directory:** Contact information for all participating families. Directory is FREE with a voluntary donation of \$125 or more to the Cavitt PTC.
 - **Planner:** This is the first step in ensuring your student's success, customized for Cavitt. The planner will be on sale during Orientation for a voluntary donation of \$10. If you choose to use another form of planner instead of the Cavitt School Planner you will need to request the Student Handbook and Required Forms from the school office.
 - **Yearbook:** Purchase one for your student to help celebrate a successful 2017-2018 school year.
 - **P.E. Clothes:** Required for P.E. The P.E. uniform can be acquired at orientation or you may provide your own P.E. clothes that meet school requirements. (See P.E. Handbook available on the Cavitt website.)
 - **Winter P.E. Clothes:** Keep your child warm during P.E. when the weather changes. Winter P.E. clothes can be ordered at online or you may provide your own winter P.E. clothes that meet school requirements. (See P.E. Handbook available on the Cavitt website.) Due to wholesale price fluctuations, online ordering with prices will be available in the office beginning August 15th and at Orientation.
2. Proceed to the cashier line where you can present your Donation Receipt Form and pay once for all items you have selected.
 3. Upon delivery of your Donation Receipt Form, you will receive your student's schedule and locker assignment
 4. Once your items are paid, and you receive your schedule, please go to the PE tables to pick up your student's PE clothes.
